The Junior Department is Sunday School for children ages 9-12 (Primary 3-6). These children are at an age where they are starting to truly understand the significance of the gospel and are able to start making conscious choices with regards to their salvation. We have been blessed by dedicated teachers who week after week make an effort to bring alive the Bible and help these children apply the lessons they have learnt. Teaching students to walk close to God and to depend on Him starts from a young age, and as such, they are rooted in the Word of God, through verses and the shorter catechism. Sunday School is also a place for the children to fellowship with their peers. While there is no fellowship group for primary school children, the friendships they make now carry them through the years. This year, we are continuing with the use of the Bob Jones materials and we strongly encourage parents to go through the lessons with the children at home too, either as part of quiet time or maybe even as family worship. The structure of the materials is such that within a unit there are many lessons. Each week, the teachers touch on one unit. There are many lessons that are not covered in class due to time constraints. Parents can use these lessons to have conversations with their children about the Bible, learn more about missionaries or even to know more about favourite hymns often sung in Church.

Finally, besides the usual Sunday School lessons, once a month (second Sunday of the month), the Junior Department has Open Sunday at the Music Room. Working with the Music Ministry, the children are in the midst of recording some songs and we hope to create a collection by the end of the year. The CD would hopefully be a source of encouragement and blessing to the congregation. Last week, the children presented one of the many songs they have learnt during their Open Sunday sessions. The song echoes the heartbeat of each and every child, to walk in the guidance and protection of the Saviour. May this serve as a reminder to both the children and the congregation of God's love and providence to us, step by step, day by day.
