The Sunday School Young Teens Department gives biblical instruction to our teens between the ages of 13 to 16 years old. The Bible says, "He is in the way of life that keepeth instruction: but he that refuseth reproof erreth" (Proverbs 10:17). We want our teens to listen to instruction (Proverbs 1:8; 4:1) which is the word of God, receive it (Proverbs 8:10) and hold fast to it (Proverbs 4:13).

We teach the teens the Bible is the word of God, and that God has spoken very clearly through it. In the Bible, all that we need to live our lives as required by God has been clearly revealed to us. There is nothing we need to live successfully for God that cannot be found in the Bible.

Class	Teachers	Location	Theme
Sec 1	Eld Lim C W Kwee Lan Tan Chun	Beulah Centre 2-2	<i>The Story of the Old Testament</i> Focuses on giving each student an overview of the big story (Creation, Fall and Redemption) of Scripture. Throughout the year, we will study and develop an understanding of the Old Testament's application to the New Testament.
Sec 2	Rachel Phang Wee Nah Justus	Beulah Centre 2-3	<i>The Life of Christ</i> We will explore the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies and promises as demonstrated in the life of Christ.
Sec 3	Eld Shao Sheng Sharon Seow Caleb Chia	Beulah Centre 2-4	<i>The Triumph of Christ</i> Throughout the year we will explore Acts, the Epistles, and Revelation. The book of Acts covers Christ's role in the redemptive storyline of the development of His church. The Epistles show us the truths that ground believers and allow them to live out the Great Commission until Christ returns. Finally, we will see the climactic fulfillment of His triumph over all things in Revelation.
Sec 4	Eld Michael Ong Eld Terence Tan Sally Tan	Beulah Centre 2-5	<i>Bible Doctrine</i> We will read, study, and memorize Scripture to formulate their positions in all the major doctrinal categories: the Bible, God the Father, the Son, the Spirit, man, sin, angels, salvation, the people of God, and last things. We will encourage the students to connect doctrinal conclusions to Christian living
