The Sunday School logo – a ship steering wheel (helm) superimposed on the Cross of Jesus – is such a common sight that some of us may have forgotten its symbolism. By the Lord's leading, we witnessed a surge in registration for the pre-Nursery class (18 months old to 3 years) for 2022 when a reminder was made in December last year.

As many classes are still in the virtual mode, pray that the teacher-student bond will remain strong, and the lesson delivery will stay effective. We thank God for the unwavering dedication of the teachers, their labour of love, and care for their students. Pray that the teacher-parent partnership will be strong to help the children grow well in the Lord!

I like to go to Sunday School because I like to sing songs and get to know more about Bible stories.




